



LEED Canada Documentation (NC 1.1)

DESCRIPTION

This one-day interactive workshop discusses the LEED certification process and the tools in place to assist applicants seeking LEED Canada project certification for New Construction. This workshop addresses a number of the more complex documentation requirements in the LEED NC 1.0 + addendum and the following application guides:

- Multi-Unit Residential Buildings (MURB)
- Campus and Multiple Buildings (CMB)
- Core and Shell (CS)

Due to time constraints, not all documentation requirements are discussed in detail. Please note that this workshop does not cover the NC 2009 documentation process. This workshop, like any CaGBC education program, meets eligibility requirements for the Green Associate exam. It is offered in both English and French.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The target audience for this workshop is anyone seeking LEED Canada certification for projects under the NC 1.0 Rating System and Addendum, and especially those individuals coordinating and submitting certification applications. The course also provides CE hours that meet the requirements for credential maintenance for LEED professionals, as well as prescriptive education for LEED APs without specialty upgrading to LEED AP with BD+C.

- Determine how to systematically approach and complete the LEED certification process
- Utilize the LEED letter templates to enhance a LEED certification application
- Identify what to include and what not to include in the first LEED submission
- Describe common mistakes made in LEED submissions
- Identify steps that will improve the overall quality of LEED submissions
- Describe CaGBC's process for reviewing completed applications
